### Job brief

We are looking for a test engineer who will take part in our product development efforts. Our products fall into the Software as a Medical Device (SaMD) category. While some guidelines do exist for the development of such devices, the field is new and rapidly evolving in terms of technology and regulation. The test engineer job has two aspects: 1) traditional software testing with unit and integration tests, coverage reporting, automated notifications on build failures, etc.; 2) interfacing with quality assurance and regulatory team members, in support of the company's quality system and regulatory applications. The second aspect of the role is challenging and takes us into an emerging, uncharted territory, but one that will be critically important in the near future. Our ideal hire is someone who sees this as an opportunity to gain experience in a novel domain of software engineering, while still being able to handle the day-to-day traditional responsibilities of a software test engineer.
